

Fig. S1. Anomalies of the CNS. (a) The gestational week 36 antenatal cerebral magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) showed hydrocephalus by aqueductal stenosis. (b) The neonatal cerebral MRI showed a parenchymal lesion of the mesencephalic tectum. (c and d) After 4 months the cerebral MRI with gadolinium injection confirmed the increase of the tectal and subependymal lesions (red and green arrows).
