Paraffin-embedded tissue samples from patients with non-invasive BD (A–C), micro-invasive BD (D–F) and invasive BD (G–I) were deparaffinised and stained with the anti-CD8 Ab (A, D, G), anti-granulysin Ab (B, E, H) or an anti-TIA-1 Ab (C, F, I). Sections were developed with liquid permanent red (original manifestation $\times 200$) (Asterisk: Tumour site).
