(a) Tumour tissue composed of interconnected bands of medium-large-sized spindle cells, with hyperchromatic, slightly pleomorphic nucleus, inconspicuous nucleoli and eosinophilic cytoplasm. Dilated thin-walled vessels at the periphery of the tumour with lymphangioma-like areas were present, associated with an infiltrate of lymphocytes and plasma cells (haematoxylin and eosin, original magnification $\times 40$).
