At the General Assembly the new website of Forum for Nordic Dermato-Venereology was presented. At this Nordic platform a Discussion forum (Fig. 1) has been launched where it is possible to write short comments on different topics, with the hope to boost scientific discussions on dermatology and venereology of interest for the Nordic dermato-venereologists. There are a lot of things in common but also differences that can be learned from when discussing it.

Furthermore there is a Calendar available for posting new events and meetings to help you keep up to date on what is happening in the field of dermatology (Fig. 2). What is specific with this calendar is that all the users can add their meetings themselves. When having checked if a date is available, information about a new meeting can be included by the users themselves. This information will then immediately be visible for all the colleagues.

Furthermore, Forum for Nordic Dermato-Venereology gives young dermatologists at the start of their career the opportunity to upload their profile to highlight their ongoing research projects.
