SKIBO-Diseases. Disorders Affecting the Skin and Bones. A clinical, dermatologic and radiologic synopsis by Jürgen Freyschmidt and Gisela Freyschmidt, 1998. 207 pages. Hardcover. ISBN 3-540-64042-8. Price DM198; GBP76; US\$129. Springer Verlag, Berlin.

The book describes the main features of various disorders where both the dermatologist and radiologist could be involved in the diagnosis. It includes congenital, connective tissue, rheumatic, angiodysplastic, infectious and neoplastic

disorders. The book is well illustrated with pictures of skin lesions in colour and X-ray films in black-and-white. The dermatological, radiological and clinical features of the disorders are described. The references are as a rule old except a few from German literature. For a dermatologist with access to a good textbook in dermatology I found this book to be of limited value.
