Comments by the authors: The aim of this paper is to develop a novel diagnostic algorithm from ISarcoPRM (a special interest group of ISPRM). The differences between this algorithm and the others are; special attention is paid to renin-angiotensin system-related disorders at the case finding stage, international classification of functioning model is incorporated, the regional loss of anterior thigh muscle mass/function (the most commonly/initially affected condition) is underscored, and ultrasound is used for the first time to measure the anterior thigh muscle mass. Just to note that this is the first-ever consensus algorithm of musculoskeletal physicians on the diagnosis of sarcopenia in older adults.Read more and watch this video for a brief summary of the main findings
